## Garbage Disposal Guidelines

CSW offers garbage disposals in each apartment as an added amenity for our residents. While garbage disposals provide a convenience to residents, everyone must understand the guidelines and limitations of a garbage disposal in terms of what, and how much, can be effectively placed in the garbage disposal. Proper measures should be taken to ensure continued functioning of your garbage disposal.

**PLEASE DO NOT PLACE any of these food items into a garbage disposal:**

- Grease or cooking oils
- Peels/rinds
- Pastas or Rice
- Celery
- Corn husks
- Pea pods
- Egg shells, Seafood Shells
- Meats and Bones
- Excessive quantities of any food product
- Any non-food items (e.g. cat litter, gravels, glass, metal, chemicals)

Run water for at least 20 seconds after you switch the disposal off.

If not sure, don't put in the disposal.

Large food products of any kind as well as heavy amounts of food should never be placed into your garbage disposal. Garbage disposals are not designed to process large amounts of any items.

As noted above, do not place any non-food items into the garbage disposal. Examples of such items include (but are not limited to) coins, aquarium gravels, silverware, packaging, cat litter, etc.

Following these simple rules should help you to avoid overflowing sinks, congested plumbing and/or other annoyances for both you and your neighbors.

***Important: There will be a maintenance fee for repairs  
due to any items being disposed of improperly  
or for any inappropriate usage of the garbage disposal.***
